## *Fort Dalles Riders Association / Duane Fulps Memorial Scholarship Scholarship Criteria*

Applications will be given to any qualifying high school or home schooled senior of current year.

1. Qualifying applicant must be an active member of the Fort Dalles Junior Riders and graduate with a high school diploma or a CAT score of 800 or better.
  - a. An active member is defined as:
    - i. Attending at least half of the Junior Riders meetings, held once a month in the prior 12 months.
    - ii. Helping with Junior Rider's fund raisers, play days, horse shows, etc.
    - iii. Helping with the maintenance of the Fort Dalles Riders arena, grounds and clubhouse.
    - iv. Participation in activities with the Fort Dalles Riders as a club.
2. Send to the Fort Dalles Riders Association:
  - a. A completed application
  - b. Activity Sheet
  - c. Two written personal reference letters
    - i. One from a teacher or tutor
    - ii. One from anyone other than a family member
  - d. Transcript of your grades from your school or CAT scores (home school) taken during your senior year.
3. Application must be received by the Fort Dalles Riders Association no later than the April 15<sup>th</sup> of current year.
4. After receiving all applications, a panel of 4 judges will be chosen by the board to conduct application judging and personal interviews. Applicants will be contacted to set up individual interview time.
5. Applicants are judged as follows:

40% Application (presentation & completion)
30% Personal Interview
30% Club Participation
6. A scholarship of \$1500 for first place and \$1000 for second place will be presented at recipient's school awards night, or at the Fort Dalles Rider's Clubhouse. Time and location to be determined.

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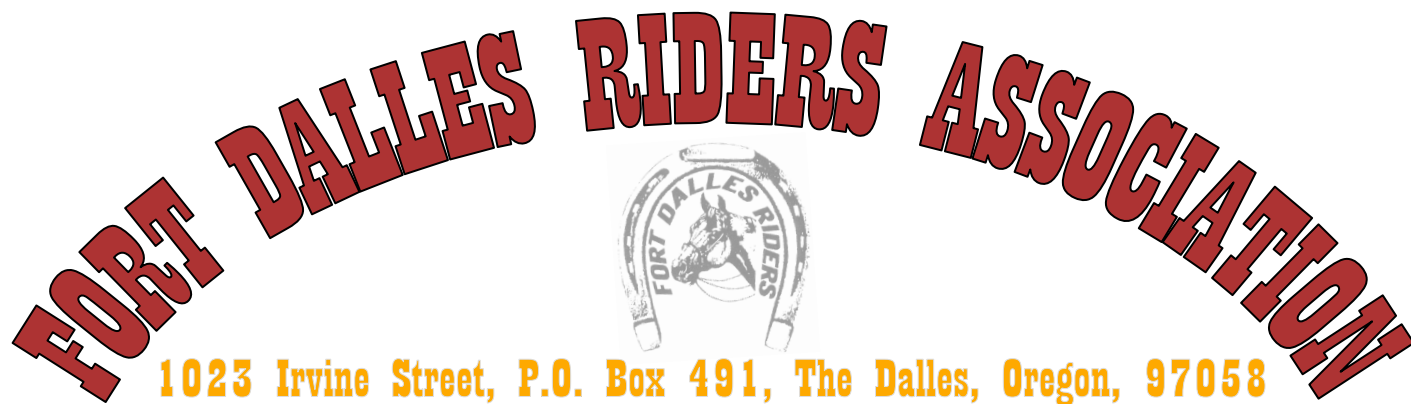
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## *Fort Dalles Riders Association Bio*

With a lighted outdoor arena, The Fort Dalles Riders are able to host many activities including, but are by no means limited to: riding lessons (dressage, western, jumping, English), horse shows, clinics and training, playdays, barrel racing, gaming, square dancing, parades, and of course, trail riding.

## *Duane Fulps Memorial Scholarship Bio*

Duane Fulps died on October 25, 1992. In his obituary, it was suggested that donations in his honor be made to the Fort Dalles Junior Riders, to help a youngster or two with expenses on their horse. As a result of this suggestion, over \$500.00 was received.

The next year, Vicki Sallee suggested that the fall Fort Dalles Riders Horse Show be designated as a scholarship fund raiser in Duane's name.

So far to date, the Fort Dalles Riders Association has awarded over 22 scholarships totaling more than \$16,250.00.
